

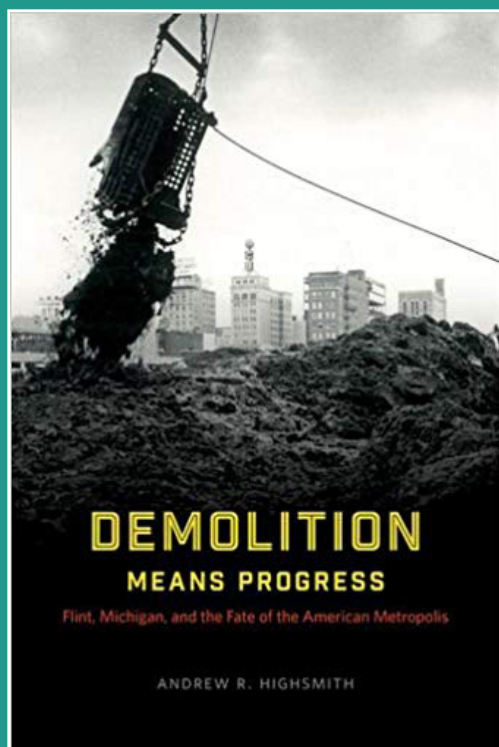


Community Read 2018-2019
